Each ml contains: Tylosin Tartrate 100 mg.

Appearance

colorless or slightly yellow transparent liquid.

Good Manufacturing Practice



- · Infections caused by microorganisms sensitive to tylosin, such as respiratory infections in cattle, sheep and swine, Duchenne dysentery in pigs, dysentery and arthritis caused by Mycoplasma bovis, mastitis and endometritis.
- Hypersensitivity to tylosin and cross-sensitization to macrolides.





Usage and dosage

- 1. Intramuscular or subcutaneous injection.
- 2. Cattle: 0.25 0.5 ml per 10 kg body weight per day for 3 5 days.
- 3. Calves, sheep, goats: 0.7 21 ml per 50 kg body weight per day for 3 5 days.
- 4. Pigs: 0.25 0.4 ml per 10 kg body weight every 12 hours for 3 days. Dogs: 0.2 1 ml.
- 5. Dogs, cats: 0.25 1 ml per 10 kg bw per day for 3 5 days.
